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Spell Africa International is a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) aimed at providing access to education to less privileged children in the society through awards of scholarship and also motivating the interest of children in education by organising spelling competitions and rewarding excellence.

The NGO is a Nigerian organisation with head-office in Ogun State, Nigeria and presence in some English speaking African countries like Ghana, Liberia, Sierra Leone and Gambia. Spell Africa Int'l currently has 33 children on full scholarship in Nigeria and is further working towards reaching out to more children in Nigeria and other African countries, while also motivating the interest of children in education and rewarding excellence through spelling competitions.

BACKGROUND

SPELL AFRICA INT'L is a product of pure compassion and sense of purpose in service to humanity. The Founder's narrative best captures her experience during her third year in the University, which planted this vision in her. According to her, she witnessed a group of armed robbers that were put to death. Among them was a 16year old boy who was out of school because his parents could not afford his Education. She gathered some information from people that the boy's parents could not afford to take care of him and his siblings, and in order to survive, the poor boy started stealing to make ends meet. He was negatively influenced by his peers into armed robbery which led to his untimely death in one of their operations. As much as we do not consider excuses for engaging in any vices, we also do not shy away from the root causes of some involvements. She further said when she witnessed the account of this poor boy, she was moved with compassion and made a vow to God that if He blesses her, she will ensure a minimum of 1,000 children get scholarship for Primary and Secondary Education; and if He blesses her more, she will ensure they get scholarship as well for University Education. This sense of purpose is what drives everything about SPELLAfrica Int'l.

ACHIEVEMENTS SO FAR

SPELL Africa Int'l has successfully planned and organized 14 Editions Spelling Leaders Competition across 19 States in Nigeria, Lagos, Ogun, Delta, Ekiti, Oyo, Osun, Ondo, Ekiti, Kwara, Rivers, Anambra, Enugu, Imo, Plateau, Taraba, Adamawa, Kano, Niger, Kogi and Abuja. These competitions have featured over 9000 spellers across the country in 5 years and the organisation is committed to awarding more scholarships for increased number of less-privileged children and also motivating the children's interest in education and rewarding excellence through spelling competitions. The NGO is currently planning international editions of the spelling competition to host schools from other English speaking parts of Africa, to be hosted in Nigeria.

SOURCES OF FUND

The organisation is currently mainly funded by the founder's personal resources and the resources made from schools that pay to register their Spellers for the spelling competitions. This of course, alone in itself, is not sustainable considering the milestone the NGO has to achieve. We are still making sustained efforts to reach out to individuals and corporate organizations, local and international agencies with genuine interest in promoting quality education and reaching out to the less privileged.

MY SPELL AFRICA STORY

Gift Akwejevu - Founder/President



In my third year in the University in 2013, I witnessed a group of robbers who were killed and among them was a 16 year old boy. I did some findings on the 16 year old boy and found out that he dropped out of secondary school because his parents could no longer afford to see him through school and he joined the armed robbery gang due to peer influence. I was touched by the findings and made a vow to God that if he blesses me, I will provide scholarship for at least one thousand children from Primary to Secondary School and if he blesses me more, I will sponsor many through University. This dream stayed alive in me until I graduated in 2014.

In 2015, I had a life transforming spiritual experience that further inspired my vow of providing scholarships for less privileged children. I attended a Living Faith Church in Benin and in that live broadcast service, I had the opportunity of hearing Bishop David Oyedepo talking about the pursuit of vision. My vow to provide scholarships for less privileged children became clearer to me as a vision worth pursuing. I became a committed Member of the Living Faith Church where I received more teachings on the pursuit of vision and purpose.

In 2017, after participating in the January 21 Days Fasting and Prayers, I was further inspired to pursue the vision of providing scholarships for less privileged children, despite not being financially capable. In April same year, I had a dream where I saw myself in a well lighted big hall speaking to an audience of school age children, inspiring them on the importance of education. In that dream, I got the name, SPELL Africa Int'l, an NGO that motivates the interest of young people in education while providing scholarship for less privileged children. It was initially difficult getting the support of my parents and family members; the family expectation was for me to seek a job and start making money for myself and not to start an NGO without a capital base. With God and the strength of a clear vision, I was able to pursue my dream.

The journey fully kicked off in 2017. On Saturday, the 28th October, 2017, we had a successful maiden Spelling Leaders Competition in Ogun State with 66 Schools, featuring over 500 Contestants in attendance. At the end of the event, we were able to provide scholarship for the first less privileged child in Partnership with Noble Crown Schools. In 2018, we had second, third and fourth Editions of Spelling Leaders Competition and were able to provide scholarships for additional less privileged children. In subsequent successful editions, we were able to add additional less privileged children into our scholarship programme. Currently, we have 33 less privileged children on scholarship at Primary and Secondary Schools in different States in Nigeria and we desire to do more when we have more.





Prior to the National and International dimension which came up in 2022, the competition had been holding at States level in the different Editions at one centre in each of those States. The National/International dimension started in July, 2022, after the successful hosting of the 13th Edition in June, held at Jos, Plateau State. In this National/International Edition which started at Eko Hotels, Victoria Island, Lagos, followed by Mandate School at Mainland, Lagos, the Competition has been successfully hosted in 19 States and the FCT, with Qualifiers for the Nationals emerging to represent the states. Over 9,000 contestants have participated in the competition so far.

In the course of hosting this National/International Edition, our team visited Ghana, Sierra Leone, Liberia and Gambia. By the grace of God, SPELL Africa Int'l has now been fully registered and recognized in Ghana, Sierra Leone and at advanced stage of full legal registration and recognition in Gambia and Liberia with team members on ground in those countries. The inability to host concurrently in these four English speaking African countries was due to delays in getting legal recognition, which are being fully sorted ahead of next Editions.

Finally, just as it is common with every vision and

noble course, the journey has not always been a bed of roses, but it has been worth all the efforts. The support of Covenant University and other organizations like Eko Hotels, WAZOBIA FM, Cool FM, Nigeria Info and host schools across the nation, has made the load a lot lighter all the way. The current feat would not have been possible without the resolute commitment of the SPELL Africa team, the strategic engagement of the Project Management Consultancy Team and some supportive individuals working mainly behind the scene. My Parents and Family have been there for me when I need them. I look forward to greater days ahead with opportunity to motivate the interest of more children in education while providing more scholarships to less privileged children across Africa.

I am delighted to welcome you to the 2023 Nationals/Grand Finale of Spelling Leaders International Competition hosted by the Covenant University Community Development Impact Initiative Committee (CU-CDIIC) in partnership with Spell Africa International. I warmly welcome all the great spellers and officials from various schools across the country to our serene campus, known as Hebron- the birthplace of kings and queens, where a new generation of leaders are raised to soar like Eagles. I equally congratulate all the prodigious spellers for scaling all the huddles from the state preliminaries to make it to this national finale.

This competition is holding on the heels of some disturbing statistics recently rolled out by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) which shows that Nigeria has become the epicentre for the rising number of out-of-school children in sub-Saharan Africa. According to UNESCO, as of October 2022, about 20 million children are out-of-school in Nigeria. The World Bank also affirms that Nigeria is undergoing a learning deficiency in which 70 per cent of 10-year-old children cannot understand a simple sentence or perform basic numeracy tasks. This points towards a bleak future for our nation, considering the escalation of crime rate, insurgency, and

poverty in the land that further exacerbates the problem.

However, one of the ways to minimize this learning deficiency is through spelling skill development. Spelling is considered a critical part of literacy, including reading and writing. As a matter of fact, spelling is one of the most important fundamentals of successful writing and reading, which enhances comprehension skills. For instance, studies have shown that students proficient with letters and word arrangements can read and understand more complicated scripts. They also possess the language skills to express their thoughts through spoken and written communication.

Other studies also have shown that people with advanced spelling skills have more opportunities in school and professionally than those who do not develop these skills. Furthermore, the spelling competitors gain the knowledge essential to develop a healthy sense of sportsmanship and friendly competitiveness. Such students are encouraged to interact with each other and connect over a mutual interest in language. They also gain confidence in public speaking and other performing arts. Equally, teaching fledgling spellers the rules, concepts, and strategies to develop their spelling and vocabulary understanding impact all facets of their learning and daily life.

One of the ways to develop spelling skills is through engagement in the spelling competition. The oldest of such competitions is the Spelling Bees, formerly known as Spelling Match, which started in 1808 in the United States. The inspiration to create the competition was derived from Noah Webster's Spelling Books, first published in 1789. The books were an important part of the curriculum of all elementary school children in the US for five generations.

Today, many such competitions are being organized across the globe. However, I want to commend Spelling Africa International for its unique vision and brand of competition aimed at providing access to education to

less privileged children in society through awards of scholarships and motivating the interest of children in education by organizing spelling competitions and rewarding excellence. Also, I applaud the visioner and her team for sustaining and expanding this laudable vision beyond our national frontiers to other African countries.

As a Centre of knowledge, Covenant is delighted to partner with Spell Africa International through CU-CDIIC (which we have done since 2019) to organize this Spelling Leaders International Competition to raise a crop of spellers among our primary and secondary students. The University hosted the Ogun State Preliminary of the competition on February 7, 2023, and we are excited this national climax is also taking place on our campus. We, therefore, expect that participants will have their spelling and presentation skills, as well as competitive skills, enhanced by the close of this event.

SPELL AFRICA INT'L GIANT STRIDES 2022/2023

VISIT TO GHANA

The SPELL Africa Management and Project Management Consultancy Team's visit to Ghana in October, 2022 was a hugely successful one. It wasn't the first visit to the Country but it provided additional opportunity to meet with the Ghana Education Service's top Management, where we received warm reception and verbal assurance of the support of the GES to host the Programme in Ghana. At our visit, we also got approval from Knutsford University on their readiness to be the host for Greater Accra and National level competition. Due to the change in the Leadership of Ghana Education Service shortly after our visit, the written approval experienced delay. This delay was responsible for the inability to meet up with the 14th Edition.



VISIT TO SIERRA LEONE

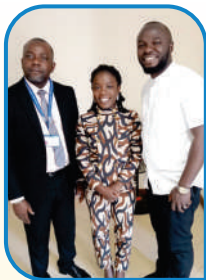
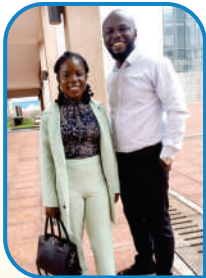


During the visit to Sierra Leone by the team in November, 2022, the SPELL Africa International Project was well received in the country and registration of the organization was completed. There was also visits to the Federal Ministry of Education in the Country with very warm reception and affirmation of support for the project. The Project Coordinating Team in Sierra Leone was also well constituted at the visit and actively working since then. The country is optimistic about being part of the 15th Edition coming up next.



VISIT TO LIBERIA

The visit to Liberia which was made possible in November was another huge success as we got the nod of the authorities to introduce our competition into the Country. The registration of the organization in the country is in Process. The Project Coordinating Team in the country was also well constituted and actively working. The country has shown strong interest to be part of the next Edition, having not been able to meet up with the 14th Edition concluded in 2023.




VISIT TO THE GAMBIA



The visit to the Gambia was made possible in February, 2023. The Ministry of Education was visited and verbal approval was given to host the program in the country, which was later backed up with a written approval. Due to time constraint to meet up with the 14th edition, the country has shown strong commitment to be part of subsequent editions.

CONCLUSION

In all of these countries, the Project enjoyed warm reception but time spent going through the due processes of approval made it difficult to meet up with the pace of the Project in Nigeria, necessitating the shift of the hosting in these countries to the next edition. At the next edition, the competition is expected to be hosting concurrently in these countries alongside Nigeria.
